A. - A(i). <u>Public Hearing: Consideration of Resolution 2023-04 Levying Special Assessments Within Zones of Benefit:</u> Following summary comments by staff, President Palla opened the Public Hearing and asked if there was anyone present wanting to comment on the item. Seeing none, President Palla closed the Public Hearing and returned the item to the Board for discussion and action.

M/S/C (Spitzer/Fanucchi) (yes-8, no-0): By unanimous vote, with Director Borba absent, the Board adopted Resolution 2023-04 Levying Special Assessments Within Zones of Benefit as presented.

- B. <u>Business & Finance Committee Report November 16, 2023:</u> District Controller Duncan provided a report from the November Business & Finance Committee Meeting.
- B(i). <u>Approval of October 2023 Financial Reports:</u> Mr. Duncan presented the October 2023 District and Water Banking Project(s) Financial Statements, Treasurer's Reports, and District Delinquency Report.

M/S/C (Antongiovanni/Kaiser (yes-8, no-0): By unanimous vote, with Director Borba absent, the Board approved the October 2023 District and Water Banking Project(s) Financial Statements, Treasurer's Reports, and Delinquency Report as presented.

IV. OPERATIONS AND PROJECTS

- A. A(i-iv). <u>Operations and Projects Committee November 7, 2023:</u> Assistant General Manager Bellue briefly reported on several items. Mr. Bellue's update included District maintenance activities, recent encroachment permit requests, pending development projects impacting District facilities, and a status update related to the Sunset Groundwater Banking project.
- B. B(i.-ii). Winter Shutdown Maintenance Plan: Staff briefly discussed the various maintenance activities and projects that are planned for the winter shutdown period. After a very wet year, which necessitated extended operations of all District facilities, staff will be utilizing outside resources to assist during the winter shutdown period. Staff discussed the use of Cross Land Leveling Inc. to facilitate needed dredging along the Kern Island Drain and Rim Ditch as well as the use of Ruben's Pipeline, Inc. to replace a canal crossing on the Kern Island Drain (Recommended for approval by the Operations and Projects Committee).

M/S/C (Mendonca/Spitzer (yes-8, no-0): By unanimous vote, with Director Borba absent, the Board approved Service Agreement 2023-09 with Lonnie A. Cross Land Leveling Inc. for dredging along the Kern Island Drain and Rim Ditch, in an amount not to exceed \$356,290 and Service Agreement 2023-10 with Ruben's Pipeline, Inc for the replacement of a canal crossing on the Kern Island Drain, in an amount not to exceed \$49,742.

V. WATER RESOURCES REPORT

- A. A(i-iii). <u>District Watermaster Report:</u> Staff reviewed and discussed the water supplies of the District for the month of October and early November. Approximately 26,336 acre-feet of water was diverted in District during October. Staff also provided information related to current precipitation totals and future forecasts.
- B. B(i). <u>Kern River Watermaster Report:</u> The November Kern River Watermaster Report included in the Board packet.
- C. <u>District Groundwater Manager Report:</u> Groundwater Manager Marquez provided graphical information regarding depth to groundwater at various monitoring locations throughout the District. In addition, Ms. Marquez provided a brief update regarding other work she is engaged in with respect to other regulatory programs such as the Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program and SGMA.

VI. MANAGER'S REPORT

- A(i). <u>SGMA Update</u>: Mr. Teglia provided a brief verbal report regarding current SGMA activities. This included a discussion regarding basin wide coordination efforts.
- B. External Agency Report: Mr. Teglia provided verbal comments supplementing a memorandum included in the Board package which provided information on the meetings and activities of various external agencies. These agencies include, but are not limited to, the Kern County Water Agency, Kern Fan Authority, Kern River Watershed Coalition Authority, Kern Groundwater Authority, Kern River Groundwater Sustainability Agency, the South Valley Water Resources Authority, the Water Association of Kern County, and the Integrated Regional Water Management Plan.
- C. <u>Water Banking Projects Report:</u> Mr. Teglia provided verbal comments supplementing a memorandum included in the Board package which provided information on water banking project activity on the Kern Fan as well as District banking activities.



AGENDA ITEM 16: SUNSET GROUNDWATER RECHARGE FACILITY PUMP STATION OVERHEAD ELECTRICAL SERVICE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT

BACKGROUND: In the fall of 2018, Board of Directors for both Arvin-Edison (AE) and Kern Delta (KD) approved the joint purchase of ~150 acres of "Stenderup Property" located within AE for a future recharge facility (site map enclosed) for various purposes but mainly due to the property location being in an area of historic low groundwater elevation and therefore beneficial for SGMA implementation (chronic lowering of groundwater levels, positive water budget, and cross boundary flows).

Since the property purchase, both AE and KD have executed two cost share agreements to continue the development of the Sunset Groundwater Recharge Facility (Project) including environmental documentation (adopted in July 2020) and design services.

In September 2021, the Earthwork/Structures portion of the Project was awarded to the lowest responsible bidder being Wood Bros with a bid of \$1,666,689.67 and after construction management and other contingencies, the total Phase 1 advance of \$2,000,000 was split equally (50/50 or \$1,000,000 AE share) with Kern Delta pursuant to the Project Operation and Maintenance agreement dated April 22, 2021. The Project was completed in March 2022.

In August 2022, after competitive bidding, the apparent lowest responsible bidder for the Pump Station and Pipeline portion of the Project was Specialty Construction with a bid of \$3,760,908 and Zeiders Consulting task order for construction management, testing and inspection for \$400,805. In addition to the construction contract, an additional \$350,000 was recommended to be budgeted to expediate electrical distribution service to the new Pump Station. Given equipment lead times on electrical drives, panels, and pumps, the Pump Station portion of Project is estimated to be completed in February 2024.

Final total Project costs for the Property, Earthwork/Structures, Pump Station, Pipeline and Electrical service will be prepared upon Project completion (currently amounts to approximately \$10.6M). The O&M Account is subject to reimbursement upon completion of the entire Project.

ELECTRICAL SERVICE PROJECT: In August 2023, due to material deficiencies in the initial round of bidding, the Overhead Electrical Service portion of the Project was re-advertised in October 2023 and bids were received December 4th from three contractors as summarized below:

AC Electric is the apparent lowest responsible bidder for the Overhead Electrical Service portion of the Project with a bid of \$197,350. It shall be noted the District is supplying the six (6) new transformers from its inventory due to a 52-week lead time (District has ordered replacements).







CURRENT RESERVOIR CONDITIONS



Water year 2023 provided much-needed relief following three of the most severely dry years on record. However, water year 2024 is off to a slow start with precipitation amounts at about half of average in October and November. To make the initial 2024 allocation, the Department of Water Resources (DWR) forecasts what water supplies will be available if the current dry pattern continues through the remainder of the water year 2024. As a result, DWR is initially allocating 10 percent of most State Water Project (SWP) contractors' requested Table A amounts for 2024, as shown in Attachment A – 2024 SWP Allocation. The dry start to this year is a reminder that we must continue to prepare for swings between wet and dry conditions.

To determine the available SWP water supplies, DWR considers factors including SWP contractors' anticipated 2023 carryover supplies into 2024, projected 2024 demands, existing storage in SWP conservation facilities, estimates of future runoff, SWP operational and regulatory requirements from the Federal Endangered Species Act and California Endangered Species Act, and water rights obligations under the State Water Resources Control Board's authority. DWR may revise the SWP allocation if hydrologic conditions change.

DWR will develop the 10-percent water delivery schedules by prorating the 15-percent schedules submitted by the Contractors in October 2023 (as part of initial requests) with any subsequent updates. If a contractor foresees any changes to their water delivery schedule, please communicate such changes to DWR in a timely manner.

RE: Report of Recent Activities

Isabella Reservoir Operations - Storage at midnight on November 16th was 211,906 ac-ft. Storage at midnight on December 10th was 196,889 ac-ft. The mean inflow for this time period was 627 cfs and the mean outflow was 903 cfs. Current reservoir conditions for December 10th (attachment 1) shows the average storage for this date is 140,216 ac-ft and the current storage is 196,889 ac-ft.

Precipitation

- The December 11th CNRFC Kern River basin forecast (attachment 2) is showing the April July season runoff to be 68% of mean and 103% of median.
- The Tulare Basin Precipitation: 6-Station Index, December 11th shows 22% of average for this date (attachment 3). This is a 3% increase as compared to November 11, 2023.
- Accumulated precipitation for WY 2024 at the following snow sensors is (attachment 4)
 Crabtree Meadow elevation 10,700 feet 3.52 inches
 Pascoes 9,150 feet 1.44 inches
 Beach Meadows 7,650 feet 1.08 inches
- The NOAA Climate Prediction Center 8-14 day and Seasonal Three-Month Outlook for Dec-Jan-Feb is showing both temperatures and precipitation to be leaning above normal (see attachments).

Aerial Snow Observatory - Department of Water Resources held their 2nd Aerial Remote Sensing of Snow (ARSS) program update meeting with ASO Inc. and all of the cooperators on December 11th. The tentative plan for the Kern River watershed is 3 flights tentatively scheduled for Feb, Mar and May/Jun.


KDWD Water Banking Project:



2023 Estimated Kern Fan Banking Project Deliveries (by Water Type) Deliveries through October 31, 2023 Total Deliveries 802,616 af




2023 Estimated Kern Fan Banking Project Deliveries (by Project)




Cross Valley Canal October 2023 Deliveries Total deliveries 52,729 af




Cross Valley Canal Twelve Month Delivery by Direction
